Professor Ketevan Nemsadze is a leading scientist of Georgian pediatry.

She was born on the 1st of July 1949 in Kutaisi.

1973 – She graduated from the Tbilisi State Medical University Pediatric Faculty.

1982 – Scientific degree of Candidate for the work: "State of humoral and cell-mediated immune system during neonatal staphylococcal sepsis". Pediatrics (14.00.09) Allergology-immunology (14.00.36).

1994 – 1999 - Chief pediatrician of Georgian Ministry of Health;

K. Nemsadze participated in more than 50 international conferences, in most of them as an invited speaker or as a member of organizing committee.

She is a recipient of 2 copyright certificates (1991; 1710060; 1725900) from the State Committee of Science and Techniques of the Soviet Union and a patent certificate from the Georgian Committee of Science and Techniques (N5(1410060) 1994) for the inventions made in the field of sepsis management.

K. Nemsadze is an initiator and co-author of the Georgian Law "Breastfeeding protection and support, controlled usage of artificial food" (1999). The law has been introduced into the international code documentation center on infant feeding as a Model Law, UNICEF, 2003.

Since 2001 - temporary adviser of WHO European Regional Office on the topics Of Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative, Management of Respiratory And Diarrheal Diseases And Concept Of Adolescent Friendly Medical Services.

2006 - 2010 – On demand of WHO Regional Office for Europe K. Nemsadze with the expert group elaborated 4 teaching modules of "Effective Perinatal Care":

- Manual for training trainers in Neonatology and Obstetrics & Gynecology
- Manual for preparation of Neonatology specialists
- Manual for preparation of Obstetrics & Gynecology specialists
- Course of Director's Guide

These curriculums were successfully implemented in Ukraine and Georgia.

2011-2013 K. Nemsadze was an Advisor-Neonatologist of Ukraine presidential initiation “New Life” in the process of perinatal system organization. Within this project K. Nemsadze was a co-author of 2 manuals of “Advanced Neonatal Care”, that was elaborated for physicians and participants of the course.

1995 – present – Development and implementation of in- and outpatient treatment standards for 0-5 year-old children; Prehospital standard development via implementation of WHO/UNICEF principles of integrated management of childhood diseases at the primary level of pediatric services, BFHI principles in the maternity houses, management principles for development and behavior abnormalities via focusing on disabled children.

K.Nemsadze implemented WHO/UNICEF principles of Integrated Management of Childhood Illness (IMCI) at the primary level of pediatric services, that helped development of the prehospital standard.
